Welcome to “Dive into JavaScript, jQuery and Pure DOM Scripting”! To participate in this course, you will need the following:

- A modern browser that you are familiar with developer tools. *Note: We will be using Chrome.*
- An IDE with JavaScript syntax highlighting.
- A local webserver to serve static pages. *Note: If you don't use Apache or comparable, below is a simple http server setup in NodeJS.*
- An open mind!

NodeJS server setup:

- Install NodeJS from <http://nodejs.org/>

Then, from a command shell:

- `$ npm install http-server -g`
- `$ mkdir frontendmasters`

Copy the contents of <https://www.dropbox.com/sh/1divchbdk5i9vin/AAAtdH8jOyTYmgRn8wcVpc5sa?dl=0> to the frontendmasters folder

- `$ cd frontendmasters`
- `$ http-server`
